## **Announcement:**

### **Ukrainian–German Summer School “International Investments” in Odessa, Ukraine, September 23– October 2, 2018**

#### **Target group:**

Bachelor students who will have achieved at least **100** Credit Points (ECTS) in their basic study courses until the end of the summer semester 2018.

#### **Short Description:**

The objective of the summer school is to provide students with unique opportunities to deepen their knowledge in international investments and to gain experiences in developing business plans. While working in international teams, students get the chance to advance their skills in effective cross-cultural communication, team work and presentation. Students will be consulted by the international team of professors from Ukraine and Germany.

#### **Participants:**

10 Students from each of the following institutions (last year of bachelor studies):

- Otto–von–Guericke University Magdeburg
- National Technical University “Kharkov Polytechnic Institute”
- Odessa National Economic University

#### **Format of the course:**

- 30 hours of lectures, 30 hours of group work at summer school, 240 hours of preliminary study and group work
- Credits: 10 (seminar)

#### **Outcomes:**

- Written business plan (10 pages)
- Group presentations of 20 minutes
- Summer school poster (A2)
